



The Faculty of Architecture and Landscape Sciences of the Leibniz Universität Hannover offers annual meetings to support young scientists in addressing research topics and discuss together relevant research questions, such as:  
How do you observe a phenomenon?  
How do you collect and analyse data?  
How do you build your theory?

The "Focusing" workshop is designed as a methodological meeting to provide monitoring and structuring tools for PhD students and young researchers. It is an alternative forum for alternative researchers, where you can discuss about your research or your future proposal with other young scientists and international researchers. An open platform for informal talks on architecture, urban planning and landscape, and find out together how to develop a healthy and fruitful research experience.

This workshop contributes to the research focus [Future Habitats](#) working in four interlinked lines of research:

- > Reflexive Design;
- > Planning for Transformation;
- > Integrated Technologies;
- > Cultural Heritage Valorisation.

The sessions will be developed with an open and critical approach, with comments and questions for each presentation. PhD students and young researchers will also work together on improving their outcomes. Your main task will be to work on a theoretical conceptual scheme showing the level of importance of the topics for your research (see figure below).




Fig. 1 Theoretical conceptual scheme
